Description

Provide a short description of the event and its activities.

The **Launching Conference of the Europe ReDefined Project** took place online via the Zoom platform on **1 July 2026**, officially marking the beginning of the FUTURENTITY initiative. Participants were required to register both via zoom and google forms to ensure secure access and to collect data. The event gathered 196 participants, bringing together representatives of all consortium partners, as well as citizens, volunteers, academics, civil society representatives and stakeholders from participating countries. In addition, participants from Serbia, Croatia and Kosovo attended the conference as invited stakeholders, contributing to a broader exchange of perspectives and experiences.

The conference aimed to introduce the FUTURENTITY project, present its objectives and planned activities, and establish a common understanding among partners and stakeholders regarding the project's vision and expected impact. The event placed emphasis on the role of digital transformation, artificial intelligence and digital storytelling in fostering active citizenship, strengthening digital competences and promoting informed participation in democratic processes.

Moreover, the event commenced with a welcome address and project presentation delivered by Mrs Cristina Bularca from Transilvania University of Braşov, the coordinating organisation of the project. During the session, participants were introduced to the project's overall objectives, thematic priorities, work packages and expected results. The presentation outlined the project's contribution to supporting citizens in navigating the challenges and opportunities created by rapid technological developments, while promoting responsible digital engagement and European cooperation.

Following the project presentation, representatives of all consortium organisations introduced their institutions, missions and areas of expertise. The participating organisations included Transilvania University of Braşov (Romania), Social Innovation and Cohesion Institute (Greece), Stichting European Institute for Diplomacy and Policy (Netherlands), Learning for Integration ry (Finland), Sloga Platforma Nevladnih Organizacij Za Razvoj, Globalno Ucenje In Humanitarno Pomoc (Slovenia), Commune d'Oletta (France), MV International (Italy) and Center for Dansk og Integration (Denmark). This session highlighted the diversity and complementary expertise of the consortium and reinforced the collaborative nature of the partnership.

The second part of the conference focused on the project's thematic area through two keynote speeches delivered by academic experts. The first keynote speech, entitled "AI Evolution," was delivered by Mr Vlad Bătrânu Pinte, Lecturer at the Department of Social Sciences and Communication at Transilvania University of Braşov. The presentation explored the development of artificial intelligence, its growing impact on society and the opportunities and challenges associated with emerging technologies. Particular attention was given to the importance of digital literacy, critical thinking and ethical considerations in the use of AI.

The second keynote speech, entitled "Digital Storytelling," was delivered by Mrs Iulia Para, Associate Professor at the Faculty of Economics and Business Administration, West University of Timişoara and Transilvania University of Braşov. The presentation highlighted the role of digital storytelling as an innovative tool for communication, education and civic engagement.

The keynote presentations were followed by an interactive question-and-answer session, during which participants exchanged views on the future implications of artificial intelligence, digital transformation and digital communication. The discussion provided an opportunity to explore common challenges faced across different countries and to identify areas for future cooperation within the framework of the project.

The conference concluded with a summary of the key points discussed and an overview of the next stages of project implementation. The event successfully established a shared understanding of the project's objectives, strengthened cooperation among partner organisations and laid the foundations for the upcoming activities. The Launching Conference contributed to raising awareness of the project's goals and fostered dialogue on the opportunities and challenges of digital transformation in contemporary European societies.
